
Confirmation Dialog When Deleting Recording





Added the feature to allow room owners to specify whether they want the room to be recorded or not.




Added functionality to pre-upload a presentation to a room.



New features for all the participants of VC



When a user is sharing a webcam feed the video indicator on the left side of the user avatar turns **GREEN**.

When a user's video feed is closed by a user, this indicator will turn **RED** (only when all webcams of the user is closed) in his user list.

When a user is not sharing his video, indicator will turn **GRAY**.

When a video feed is closed using the close button, it can be reopened again using the show video option.

The video feed of an actively talking user is focused and expanded. It can be configured by user.

One user can connect multiple webcams and show multiple video feeds with the same username

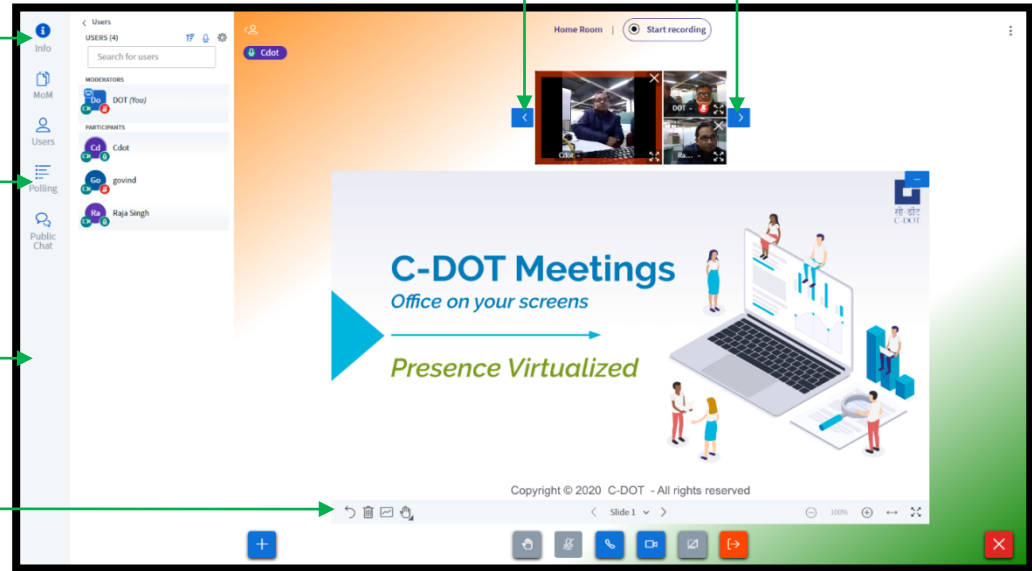
- Info tab has been added in sidebar, which displays welcome message and will be visible to every participants of the meeting .

Pagination This feature splits the videos in pages, which is user configurable. The user can move the page back and forth using the appropriate arrows to see other video streams. The user who speaks the last comes first in the video grid and hence, always visible on page 1.

The polling tab is permanently added in sidebar for presenters.

New minimal sidebar

The presentation toolbar is now moved under the presentation area screen for easy access.



Notifications (MoM, User, and Chat)

Whenever users set status or raise hand, other users in the meeting are provided with notification in sidebar in respective tabs.



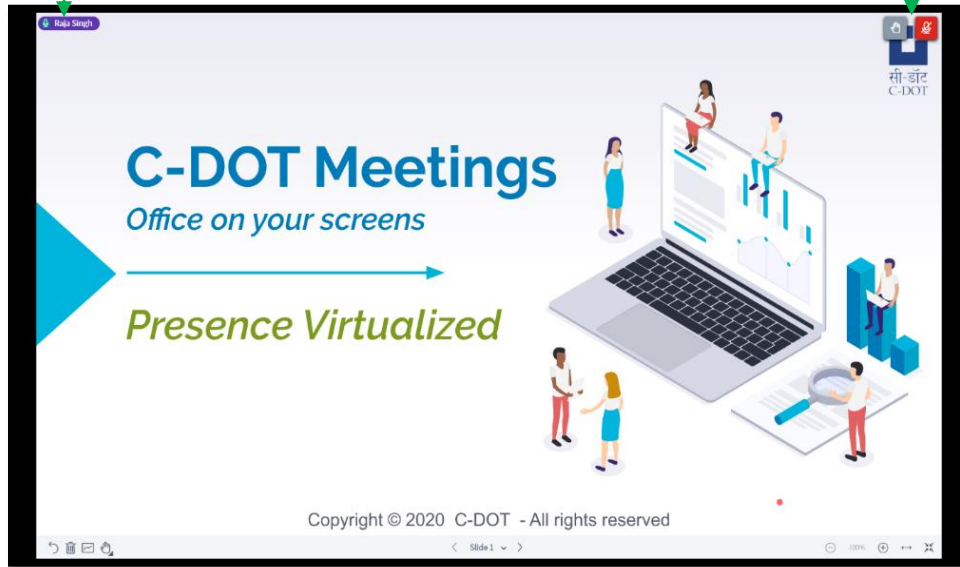

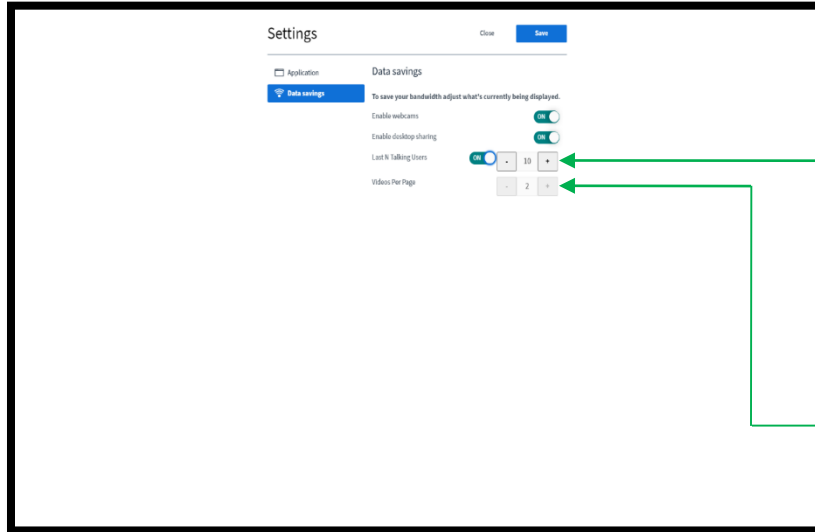
Full Screen Talking Indicators

Raise hand and mute button are added in full screen video and presentation area.





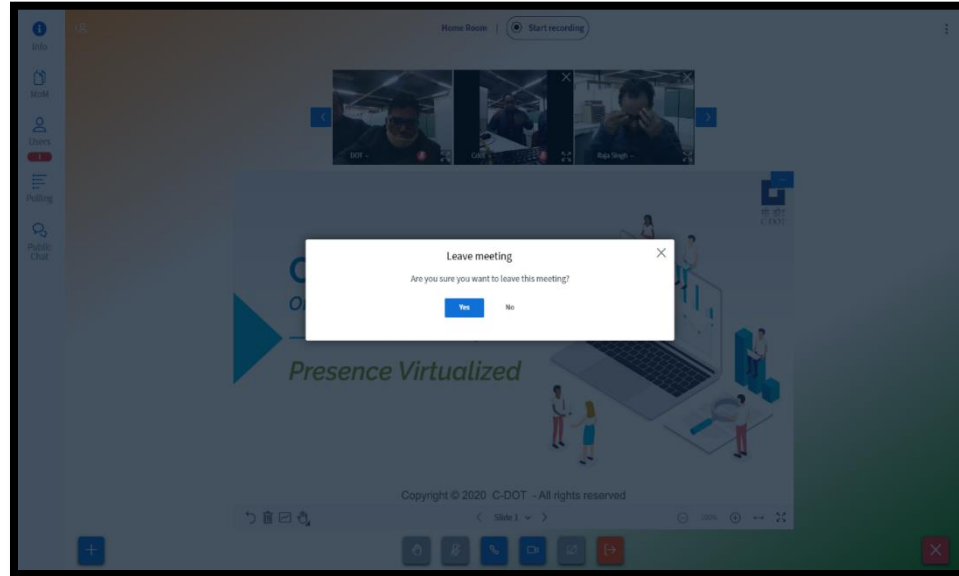
Video feed for last “N” talking users
